Will my medical insurance cover services?

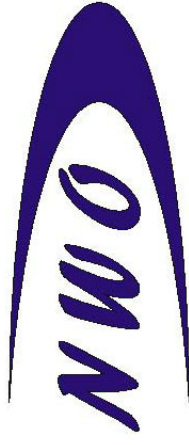
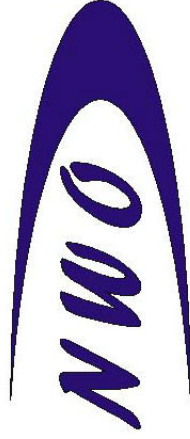

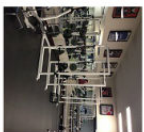

Our Facilities

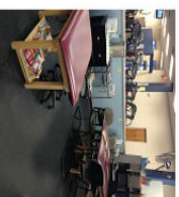
All of our physical therapy centers are equipped with state-of-the-art equipment that allows our physical therapists to offer the most innovative therapies. These include:

Our Team

The team approach used by NWO means that your physician and therapist work together to design the best evidenced based rehabilitation program for you to return to your desired activity. When your physician refers you to therapy, you will be interviewed and evaluated by a physical or occupational therapist to help determine the cause of your pain and injury and resulting loss of function. The evaluation will include a review of your history and the results of the tests your physician may have performed, an interview with you about your injury, limitations and pain, and a clinical evaluation of the range of motion, strength, neurological status, and movement patterns that may be affected by your injury. Following this your therapist will outline a plan of care to help you return to your desired activities and reach your goals.

This is a patient centered approach between your physician, your therapist, and you to ensure that you receive the best care possible.
