Will my medical insurance cover services?

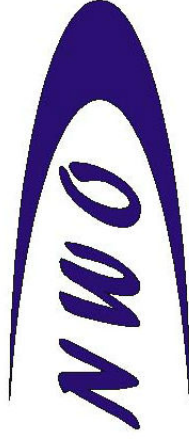

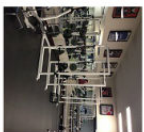

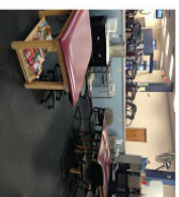
